85% Garnacha, 15% Tempranillo

Tasting Notes:

Ruby red color with violet hues. Floral aromas and ripe red fruit. In the mouth it is very sweet and fruity.

Winemaking:

Harvest: Prioritized manual harvesting. October 2023. Abnormally early harvest with low rainfall and stormy weather. Hailstorms were very prevalent, which reduced the total production of grapes. This made us be more selective during the harvest and we had to include vineyards for this wine that could have been used for higher tier wines.

Fermentation: 3 to 4 day pre-fermentative maceration, followed by temperature controlled fermentation at 22°C – 24°C in stainless steel tanks, where all the aromas are preserved.

Malolactic Fermentation: Full
