Winemaking:

Harvest: Prioritized manual harvesting. October 2023. Abnormally early harvest with low rainfall and stormy weather. Hailstorms were very prevalent, which reduced the total production of grapes. This made us be more selective during the harvest, and the total quantity made of this wine was lower than usual in order to maintain our high quality standards.

Fermentation: Temperature controlled fermentation in stainless steel tanks between 22°C – 25°C to preserve the aromas.

Malolactic Fermentation: Full
