## Justo Veneto Rosso IGT

60% Corvina, 40% Merlot

The name Justo comes from a combination of the English word Just and the Italian word Giusto – meaning Right. It is an innovative and unconventional wine, capable of adapting to various drinking occasions thanks to its easy-to-drink character. Basically, creating a wine that is “just right” for all occasions.

### Tasting Notes:

Freshness, lightness, and versatility are the defining features of Justo. On the eye, it reveals a deep red color with vibrant, intense highlights. On the nose, ripe fruit and cherry notes emerge, while the palate offers a soft, velvety texture with a light, balanced structure.

### Winemaking:

Harvest:	Machine Harvested in late September
Fermentation:	Maceration on the skins lasts about 15 days, after which the wine is moved into stainless steel tanks.
Malolactic Fermentation:	Yes - Full

### Aging:

12 months in stainless steel tanks followed by a short rest in bottle before being released.
