## Bianca

Bianca is pale and opalescent, and it is produced with a large percentage of the Garfagnana IGP spelt and wheat. It has notes of clove and fresh lemon peel on the nose. The flavor is characterized by a fresh acidity highlighted by delicate spicy notes of coriander, orange peel, and white pepper. It would pair well with fresh goat cheese, raw fish, fried vegetables or simply stand alone as an aperitivo. Serve chilled at 40-45°F.
