Varietal(s):

90% Sangiovese, 10% Canaiolo

Vineyards:

Grapes are carefully selected from the Chianti DOCG appellation of Tuscany - Italy's premiere winemaking region.

Winemaking:

Following vinification in stainless steel, the wine was aged in large Slavonian oak casks for a minimum of 24 months. It was cellared in bottle for an additional few months prior to release.

Tasting Notes:

A fuller-bodied wine bursting with aromas of ripe cherries, accented by floral nuances. The tannins are bold, showing its potential to age gracefully over the next few years. However, extensive cellaring prior to release makes it approachable now.
