40% Grenache, 25% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Syrah,
10% Cinsault, 5% Mourvedre

Tasting Notes:

This traditional dry Provencal rosé is bright and fruit-forward with exotic fruit that remind of guava and papaya, and white floral aromas on the nose. It has body and structure, yet is fresh on the palate and beautiful minerality.
A versatile wine that pairs beautifully with a wide variety of seafood.
Serve chilled when young.
