DueTorri is a collection of native and international varietal wines produced by Cesari, the famed Valpolicella winery. These fruit-forward wines are varietally accurate expressions of Italy's diverse terroir.

Varietal(s):

100% Cabernet Sauvignon

Vineyards:

Introduced to northern Italy's Friuli-Venezia-Giulia from Bordeaux, France around 1820, Cabernet enjoys the rocky soil of the hillside vineyards located in Grave del Friuli. Cesari works very closely with a stable of growers with whom they have long-standing relationships and are known for quality.

Winemaking:

Vinified in stainless steel to preserve the natural varietal characteristics of the grapes, the wine is released a few short months following the vintage.

Tasting Notes:

Layered with aromas and flavors of earth and herbs, followed by raspberries and blackberries. The finish lingers on the palate. This Cabernet will develop in bottle for a few years following the vintage. Serve within 5 years alongside roasted meats or poultry or vegetable-heavy stews.
