## Nebbiolo d'Alba 'Valmaggiore' DOC

The vineyards of this famous Cru are situated on very sandy and rugged hills which means that all work in the vineyard must be carried out by hand, without the aid of tractors or other machinery. This requires laborious work driven by a pure passion to create a wine with great character.

### Varietals:

100% Nebbiolo

### Tasting Notes:

Light, ruby red color with a refined bouquet of rose, spice, and berries. It shows a full-bodied and mineral taste with an elegant yet persistent finish. Perfect on its own, but can be enjoyed with pork dishes or pasta with red sauce.

Harvest:	Hand-harvested in mid-September
Fermentation:	Gentle pressing then maceration with the skins for around 6-8 days at a maximum temperature of 28°C. At the drawing-off, the wine is decanted into Slavonian oak casks where it matures until it is bottled the following autumn where it remains for an additional 12 months before release.
