## Sangiovese

The second label by notable Emilia-Romagna producer, Umberto Cesari, produces an excellent value Sangiovese from the local strain. Sangiovese di Romagna produces a fruit-forward, varietally-correct, easy-drinking wine.

### Varietal(s):

100% Sangiovese

### Vineyards:

Stretching east from Bologna towards the shores of Rimini, vineyards under long-term lease are planted with a native clone of Sangiovese known as Sangiovese di Romagna.

### Winemaking:

Hand-harvested grapes are vinified entirely in stainless steel tanks at low temperatures to preserve the naturally fragrant characteristics of the strain. It is minimally aged to ensure maximum fruit expression and varietal characteristics, without the influence of oak.

### Tasting Notes:

An elegant bouquet of flowers and strawberries fill the nose. Dry, yet round and soft with a lingering finish. A well-balanced wine that shows best when young. Enjoy with rich, fatty charcuterie, such as Prosciutto, Mortadella, and salami. Also excellent with cajun seafood.



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
