Deeper in the collection, Capítulo Dos encourages individuality and experimentation with new varieties. This range begins to show distinct focus on the versatility, energy, and expression of each variety.

Tasting Notes:

Intense violet colour with an almost black hue. On the nose, the varietal typicity is evident, with aromas of black and red fruits combined with herbal notes that provide freshness and complexity. Full bodied on the palate with good volume, a complex wine that's intense with firm tannins and a long finish.

Vineyards:

Region: Los Chacayes, Tunuyán, Uco Valley, Mendoza
Property: Estate-Owned
Elevation: 1050 meters
Training Method: YSP
Soil Composition: Vineyard in Los Chacayes, with soil of alluvial origin, sandy loam and stony at depth. Good drainage, low moisture retention, and poor in organic matter.

Winemaking:

Harvest: The grapes are manually harvested in March. A cold maceration happens for the first days, and then alcoholic fermentation in concrete tanks.
Fermentation: During the process, gentle extraction movements are carried out, to obtain more texture, elegance and balance.
