Tauleto

90% Sangiovese Grosso, 10% Bursona Longanesi

Tasting Notes:

Ripe red fruits come through on the nose, particularly cherry. Full-bodied with a rounded mouthfeel and spicy finish that lingers on the palate. Tauleto is an age-worthy wine that needs hearty dishes to stand up to the complexities. Red meats, game, and meat-based pasta dishes work best.

Vineyards:

Region: Colli Bolognesi, Emilia-Romagna, Italy
Soil Composition: Calcareous clay, medium-consistency
Average Vine Age: 20 years

Winemaking:

Harvest: Selectively harvested by hand
Fermentation: After soft-pressing, the grapes are vinified in Slavonian oak barrels at a controlled temperature. The lengthy maceration period gives the wine a deep color and a complex flavor profile. The wine is bottled under a cold nitrogen blanket

Aging:

24 months in a combination of French Allier and Tronçais and American oak barrels, plus 6 months in bottle
